Gr. 1

ELA- we are using our letter sounds to build / read CVC words, and practicing our
Math- continuing numbers to 20 (counting forward, backward, learning 1 and 2 more and less), working on labelling patterns
Science- Primary & Secondary colors, learning about changes in Animals and Plants in the Fall
Social- just learning about the community and groups we belong to

Gr. 2

ELA: we are working on Daily 5 activities, as well as building our writing and phonics skills.
Math: working on skip counting, greater than/less than, and even and odd numbers
Science: finishing up our unit on Magnets
Social: just starting our new unit on "A Community in the Past". We will be learning about what Bashaw was like in the past.
Art: We completed a wax resist painting and are ready to begin work on some Remembrance day posters!

Gr. 3

ELA: we have been working on building sight word and decoding skills, along with spelling and use of punctuation. This group loves to write, and we are working on building our descriptive writing skills.

Social: We have been learning about the services offered in our four countries of study

Gr. 4
